

**Nuby**Reduce Reflux  
Bottle

**For your child's safety and health.  
Please read and retain this important information.**

**WARNING!**

- Always use this product with adult supervision. Accidents have occurred when babies have been left alone with drinking equipment due to the baby falling or the product has become disassembled.
- Never use feeding teats as a soother.
- Continuous and prolonged sucking of fluids will cause decay. Tooth decay in young children can occur even when non-sweetened fluids are used. This can occur if the baby is allowed to use the bottle for long periods through the day and night, when saliva flow is reduced or if it is used as a soother.
- Always check food temperatures before feeding. Heating in a microwave oven may produce localised high temperatures. Take extra care when microwave heating.
- Always stir heated food to ensure even heat distribution and test the temperature before serving.
- When making up a feed, follow the formula milk manufacturer's instructions and allow the freshly boiled water to cool before pouring it into the bottle.

**CLEANING****TIPS FOR CLEANING;**

- Before first use, clean the product.
- Clean before each use.
- Always wash the product immediately after use.
- Wash in warm soapy water and rinse in clean water or use a dishwasher.
- Do not clean with solvents or harsh chemicals.
- Do not allow product to come into contact with oil based foods (e.g. oil/tomato based sauces) as staining will occur.
- Before first use place the teat in boiling water for 5 minutes.
- Do not turn the teat inside out for cleaning. Damage could result. Use a teat brush.
- Suitable for all forms of sterilisation.

**STORAGE & USE**

- Inspect before each use and pull the teat in all directions. Throw away at first signs of damage or weakness.


- Do not store in direct sunlight or near a source of heat.
- Do not store with or allow to come into contact with solvents or harsh chemicals.
- Not suitable for use in a conventional oven or a combination microwave oven with the grill feature switched on.
- Keep all components not in use out of reach of children.
- Do not leave a feeding teat in direct sunlight or heat, or leave in disinfectant ("sterilising solution") for longer than recommended, as this may weaken the teat.
- For safety and hygiene reasons it is recommended that the feeding teat is replaced at least every 2 months.
- Do not heat in a microwave with the bottle sealed. Remove the teat, locking ring and dome cap
- Bottle and teat complies with EN14350

**ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS;**

1. Wash hands in warm soapy water and rinse in clean water.
2. Insert the silicone adapter into the inside of the teat, ensure a tight fit.
3. Push the silicone straw into the silicone adapter.
4. Connect the weight to the end of the silicone straw.
5. Push the teat through the screw ring collar.
6. Screw the bottle base to the teat collar.

**TO CLEAN:**

Disassemble all parts after each use and wash in warm soapy water. Rinse in clean water. Use a bottle brush to clean the bottle and teat, and use the cleaning brush provided to clean inside the adapter, silicone straw and weight.

**HOW TO GET THE MOST OUT OF YOUR REDUCE REFLUX™**

1. When mixing a formula feed, we recommend that you stir the milk with a sterilised spoon before attaching the teat, adapter and straw. If you do shake the bottle to mix the formula, extra air bubbles can become trapped in the milk and the pressure can cause liquid to be forced out the silicone straw. If this happens, unscrew the collar from the bottle to release pressure.
2. Once breastmilk or formula milk is at the right temperature, we recommend attaching the silicone adapter and straw. If the bottle is already assembled as the milk heats up (or cools down), expanding air pressure can force liquid out of the tube. If this happens, unscrew the collar from the bottle to release pressure
3. After feeding, rinse the silicone straw straight away. Milk can collect in the silicone straw and it is easier to clean if you rinse the straw straight away after feeding. To help you clean the hard to reach places inside the silicone adapter, silicone straw and weight, we have included a special cleaning brush with this pack. Please note that the straw can clog if you are using a specially thickened formula.
4. Re-assembling the silicone adapter and silicone straw after sterilisation. The sterilised silicone straw needs to be fully inserted into the silicone adapter that inserts into the teat/nipple. For hygiene reasons, always wash your hands in warm soapy water and rinse in clean water before assembly. Please note that most anti-colic bottles require some form of manual assembly.

**DUMMY INSTRUCTIONS****WARNING!**

- Inspect carefully before each use. Pull the dummy in all directions. Throw away at the first signs of damage or weakness.
- Only use dedicated dummy holders tested to EN 12586. Never attach other ribbons or cords to a dummy, your child may be strangled by them.
- Do not leave a dummy in direct sunlight or near a source of heat, or leave in disinfectant ("sterilising solution") for longer than recommended, as this may weaken the teat.

**CLEANING & STERILISATION**

- Before first use place the dummy in boiling water for 5 minutes, allow to cool and squeeze out any trapped water from soother. This is to ensure hygiene.
- In the event that the dummy becomes lodged in babies mouth, DO NOT PANIC, it can not be swallowed and is designed to cope with such an event. Remove from mouth with care, as gently as possible.

**REPLACE THE DUMMY AFTER ONE MONTH, FOR SAFETY AND HYGIENE REASONS.**

- Clean before each use. Wash in warm soapy water and rinse in clean water or use a dishwasher. Remove any water that may have entered the teat by squeezing the teat.
- Do not clean with solvents or harsh chemicals.
- Suitable for all forms of sterilisation.
- Do not store in direct sunlight or near a source of heat.
- Do not store or allow to come into contact with solvents or harsh chemicals.
- Never dip teat in sweet substances or medication, your child may get tooth decay.
- Always use this product under adult supervision.
- Complies with EN1400.
